THE ABOVE STATEMENT IS A COPY OF CHIKARA'S APPLICATION FOR THE INTERNATIONAL CAMP STAFF PROGRAM

Chikara Yasuda served on the Calumet Council Summer Camp Staff at Kishwaukee Scout Reservation. In 1976, after returning from Kishwaukee Scout Reservation, Chikara was killed in an automobile accident. He was 20 years old and lived in Iruma City, Japan. Chikara was a student at the Green Language School and a high school graduate. As Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, he had attended the Tokyo Wood Badge Preliminary Course. Apart from these other outstanding qualities, Chikara was the first international Scout elected into the Michigamea Lodge 110 Order of the Arrow. Because of the excellent qualities and concern for others that Chikara showed, to those of us on Camp Staff with him, and because of his great Scouting abilities, we of Michigamea Lodge offer this fund for some Scout to go to camp because we know Chikara would not want to see anyone miss the excitement of Camp.

This scholarship pays the full registration cost of attending one week of summer camp for one scout in the Calumet Council each year, whose name will be added to the Chikara Yasuda Scholarship Plaque at the council office.

To become eligible for this scholarship a Scout must:

- Be a registered Boy Scout for one year, an active member in his troop, and advanced one rank in the last year.
- Secure a letter of recommendation from Scoutmaster or another non-relative Scout Leader.
- Order of the Arrow membership is NOT required.
